

### Match The Organization With The Acronym

1. CalHFA	The department responsible for enforcing the state laws prohibiting housing discrimination.
2. CHDOS	The agency responsible for determining the regional housing needs of each community in the Los Angeles area, for use by local governments in drafting their housing elements.
3. CRA or RDA	A government agency that buys, insures and finances mortgages from local lending institutions in order to insure adequate credit.
4. DFEH	A community based non-profit housing development corporation in which 1/3 of its members are composed of low-income individuals, and which has special priority for federal HOME funds.
5. FNMA	The state agency responsible for housing bond programs and other financing programs for housing development.
6. RHS (formerly FmHA)	An agency created by local government under the Community Redevelopment Law, Health & Safety Code §§ 33000 <i>et seq.</i> , for the purpose of redeveloping or rehabilitating a blighted area.
7. HCD	The agency in the Federal Agricultural Department which is responsible for funding and providing housing to low income persons in rural areas.
8. HUD	The local agency responsible for administering public housing at the local level authorized by statute and created by local governments.
9. SCAG	The federal department responsible for funding and overseeing federal housing programs and Consolidated Plan's, as well as fair housing under federal law.
10. PHA	The California state department responsible for state planning and housing programs, including reviewing local Housing Elements, & regulating mobile homes, farm worker housing, and code enforcement efforts by local governments.
