San Francisco is only 49 square miles, so nothing is really very far. The Conference Center is located near the Moscone Convention Center, the Financial District and Union Square. Tourism is SF's lifeblood so all these areas are quite safe.

San Francisco has chains like the Day's Inn, Travel Lodge and Holiday Inn. We've included some of them here.

Most of the listed boutique hotels offer "European style" accommodations. This means that a bathroom is shared. For you Americans, \$10 - \$20 more usually will get you private baths. Parking in most places will be extra. Consider parking your car and walking or taking public transportation. If you want a true SF experience, we suggest you checkout these hotels. You really don't have to spend hundreds of dollars on a hotel room for it to be comfortable, safe and inviting.
